“Together Apart” from 4/19/20

Hebrews 10:19-25

SPOILER ALERT: *You may not want to read these until
AFTER you have heard the sermon.*

1. Have you ever heard of a “1st Person Plural Hortatory Subjunctive?” What do you like or dislike about things like grammar, syntax, and linguistics?
2. Read Hebrews 10:19-25 (or verses 1-25 if you’d like). How do these verses connect us back to Good Friday and Easter?
3. In Hebrews 10:22-25, the phrase, “let us” shows up 3 times. Using your own words, how would you explain what each of these 3 phrases is calling Christ-followers to do? What is the significance of doing each of these things TOGETHER?
4. How can our Church Family continue “meeting together” during this time while we are apart? What are you most looking forward to when this time of social distancing is over? What might you miss about the “stay-at-home” order?
5. Brainstorm some practical ways that we can practice “love and good deeds” during this time of social distancing.
6. What kind of personal help or encouragement do you need this week? If “together” is truly God’s design, then who will you reach out to in the body of Christ for help?
