Sermon-based Discussion Questions

"Attitudes in Action" from 5/17/2020 Romans 12:3-16

SPOILER ALERT: You may not want to read these until AFTER you have heard the sermon.

- 1. Share about a time when you had a bad attitude about something. If you could go back in time, what advice might you give yourself about that bad attitude? Have you ever had someone tell you, "Your attitude stinks!" How did that go for you?
- 2. Read Romans 12, verse 3 and 16. What do you think sometimes causes people to become arrogant? Why do you think it's difficult at times to keep a humble attitude? Give an example of someone associating with a person of low position? What do you appreciate about this?
- 3. Read Romans 12:10. Why do you think God calls us to honor another person above ourselves? What makes this difficult for us?
- 4. How would you explain the connection between our attitudes and our actions? Share an example of someone's attitude enhancing their action. Why is it important for Christ-followers to keep the right attitude? Explain.
- 5. Our Efree District Superintendent, Brian Farone, has encouraged Christians to "pursue unity (Ephesians 4), cultivate personal humility (Philippians 2), and model a willingness to set aside your individual rights for the sake of the Gospel (1 Corinthians 9)." How can we put this advice into action?
- 6. How can we encourage one another toward godly attitudes? What do you need prayer for this week?
