Discussion Questions | Patterns (Acts 2:42-47)

1. If you could acquire a special ability or super-power, what would it be and how would you use it? Briefly share with your group your superhero origin story.
2. Read Acts 2:41. Think back to when your eyes were first opened to spiritual things and you first understood the message of the gospel. Share with your group a bit of what it was like for you to begin to grow as a disciple of Jesus Christ.
3. Read Acts 2:42-47. How do you think we discern what is *prescriptive* (what should be true of all believers everywhere for all time) and what is *descriptive* (what was unique to the early church) in passages such as this? How might we know what to mimic and where to look for patterns?
4. Look again at Acts 2:42. What is one thing (outside of church) that you're *devoted to*? What do you think it looks like, both individually and as a church, to be devoted to gospel instruction?
5. What do you think makes community a *gospel* community? What makes fellowship *gospel* fellowship? What makes prayer *gospel* prayer? And what might a *gospel* meal look like? What impact does the gospel have on these common practices?
6. What questions do you have about the Lord's Supper/Communion? How do you think sharing in the Lord's Supper together helps us grow as disciples?
