Discussion Questions | Patterns (Acts 2:42-47) October 4, 2020

- If you could acquire a special ability or super-power, what would it be and how would you use it? Briefly share with your group your superhero origin story.
- Read Acts 2:41. Think back to when your eyes were first opened to spiritual things and you first understood the message of the gospel. Share with your group a bit of what it was like for you to begin to grow as a disciple of Jesus Christ.
- 3. Read Acts 2:42-47. How do you think we discern what is prescriptive (what should be true of all believers everywhere for all time) and what is descriptive (what was unique to the early church) in passages such as this? How might we know what to mimic and where to look for patterns?
- 4. Look again at Acts 2:42. What is one thing (outside of church) that you're *devoted* to? What do you think it looks like, both individually and as a church, to be devoted to gospel instruction?
- 5. What do you think makes community a gospel community? What makes fellowship gospel fellowship? What makes prayer gospel prayer? And what might a gospel meal look like? What impact does the gospel have on these common practices?
- 6. What questions do you have about the Lord's Supper/Communion? How do you think sharing in the Lord's Supper together helps us grow as disciples?
