1. Read Psalm 78:1-8. What grabs your attention and why?
2. In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus commissions His followers to make disciples. How do you think we should do that?
What are some barriers or challenges that can sometimes make discipleship difficult?
3. How will you grow in your own, personal discipleship this fall? Which ministry do you plan to serve in, in order to help others grow in their discipleship this fall?

4. How do you think we might best recruit all of the volunteers that we need to serve in the various ministry opportunities in our church?
What might be some good strategies if we can't seem to find enough volunteers for a particular ministry?
5. Read Acts 5:38-39. Even though this was spoken some 2,000 years ago, why is it still encouraging for us today? Would you agree that Acts 29 is “Our Chapter in Church History?” Explain.
6. Spend some time specifically praying for the discipleship mission of our church. How can we pray for you?

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
