- 2. Read 2 Timothy 4:9-22 and notice all of the names that Paul refers to. What are some things that you think we can learn from this? (See also Romans 16/Colossians 4)
- 3. Can you think of a time when you have felt disappointed in other Christians? In the church? Why do you think God designed the church as one body with many parts? Talk about finishing in 1st place vs. finishing together.
- 4. Do you know of an example when someone responded with grace after a fellow believer let them down?

 How can you and I learn to practice grace in our own relationships? At work, school, church, home, etc.?
- 5. What are some specific ways that Christians can go "Further TOGETHER?" How can our Life Group help you go further as a fully devoted follower of Jesus?
