## Sermon-based Discussion Questions<sup>1</sup>

"Reconciled" from 10/20/19 Ephesians 2:11-18 and Genesis 32-33

SPOILER ALERT: You may not want to read these until AFTER you have heard the sermon.

- 1. What stood out to you most from Bill Haas's message? Genesis 32-33 tells a story about Jacob's reconciliation with his brother, Esau. What lessons can we learn from their story?
- 2. What usually comes to your mind when you hear the word "reconciled?" How about the phrase "racial reconciliation?" What kinds of things contribute to ongoing racism in our society?
- 3. Read Ephesians 2:11-18. What does this passage reveal about how Jesus brings peace between different people groups? How does peace with God empower us to make reconciliation with others?
- 4. How does "Becoming fully devoted followers of Jesus together" relate to rational reconciliation? Do you know of any examples of Christ-followers who are models for racial reconciliation?
- 5. What is one step that you could take toward reconciliation. Toward racial reconciliation? How can our Life Group help or encourage you to pursue reconciliation?
