Sermon-based Discussion Questions¹

"The Sacredness of Every Human Life" from 1/19/20 Genesis 1:24-27

<u>SPOILER ALERT</u>: You may not want to read these until AFTER you have heard the sermon.

- 1. Share about a time in your life when you were treated unfairly or disrespectfully. What emotions did you feel? How did you and the people around you react?
- 2. In Genesis 1:26-27, why is it important for us to know that God chose to make us in His own image?
- 3. The early chapters of Genesis reveal our common ancestry and our one and the same Creator. How does this speak to our shared identity as human beings?
- 4. Without straying into politics, is there a group of people that burdens your heart the most? (Examples might be the elderly, refugees, orphans, unborn babies, people with special needs, the poor, ethnic minorities, etc.) What are some things that are being done to provide for and protect these people?
- 5. In the area of human rights, what do you think our responsibility is as Christ-followers? In light of being made in God's image, what are some practical ways that we can champion issues of human worth and dignity?
- 6. How can we help one another in our Life Group to embrace the sacredness of every human life?
