## Sermon-based Discussion Questions<sup>1</sup>

“Signs” from 3/8/20

Matthew 24:1-35

SPOILER ALERT:     *You may not want to read these until  
AFTER you have heard the sermon.*

1. Share about a time when a sign was confusing to you. It may have been an actual street sign, a GPS navigation, or something not so literal but it gave you a “gut feeling.”
2. When you read a passage like Matthew 24:1-35, do you feel intrigued, confused, or something else? How would you describe your level of interest in the End Times? What things have informed your views over the years?
3. What are some of the warnings that Jesus lays out in Matthew 24:1-35? What are some practical ways that we can apply these to our everyday lives?
4. What are some of the encouragements that Jesus gives His followers in Matthew 24:1-35? How can we apply these to our everyday lives?
5. In Matthew 24:1-35, Jesus gives some pretty graphic descriptions of what this time of great distress will be like. As Christ-followers, how should we respond to times of crisis and distress in our lives?
6. As a Life Group, how can we encourage each other to stand firm until Jesus returns?
