- 4. What are some of the encouragements that Jesus gives His followers in Matthew 24:1-35? How can we apply these to our everyday lives?
- 5. In Matthew 24:1-35, Jesus gives some pretty graphic descriptions of what this time of great distress will be like. As Christ-followers, how should we respond to times of crisis and distress in our lives?
- 6. As a Life Group, how can we encourage each other to stand firm until Jesus returns?
