Jesus Is the Bread of Life (John 6:22-59)

1. Finish this sentence in your own words: Jesus is...
2. Over the next few Sundays we are going to look at three of Jesus's *I am* statements. Why might it be good to consider what Jesus says about himself? What might be the danger in drawing conclusions about who Jesus is apart from his own testimony?
3. Read John 6:25-34. What do you think prevents us from perceiving that Jesus is our greatest need? To what degree do you think we recognize that sin is our greatest problem?
4. Take a look at James 4:1-4. What's wrong with us? What's *really* wrong with us? What does this reveal about our greatest problem and our greatest need?
5. Read John 6:35-48. In what areas of your life do you find yourself always hungry and never satisfied? How might Jesus not only stop the cravings but also leave you truly satisfied?
6. Read John 6:49-59. How would you explain to a non-Christian friend what it means to believe in Jesus? Why do you think Jesus spoke of eating his flesh and drinking his blood as a metaphor for saving faith?
