Discussion Questions

- 1. Share a particularly memorable experience you've had with hot water, cold water, or lukewarm water?
- 2. Read Revelation 3:14-22. What do you think Jesus is driving at in verses 15-16, when He says that their deeds are neither hot nor cold? How do you think we can avoid becoming "lukewarm" with our own deeds?
- 3. Verses 17-18 contrast earthly possessions with spiritual possessions. What do you think Jesus means in verse 17 by "wretched, pitiful, poor, blind, and naked?" What might cause us to get to the point where we don't realize that our faith is this far off the mark?
- 4. How does Jesus' counsel in verse 18 help us counteract the items at the end of verse 17, "poor, blind, and naked"?
- 5. Does it make sense to you in verse 19 when Jesus says, "Those whom I love, I rebuke and discipline"? Explain.
- 6. Verse 20 gives us a word picture of Jesus knocking at the believer's door and being ready to "come in and eat with that person." How might this help us to repent?
- 7. Now that we've looked at all of Jesus' letters to the 7 churches, what might be some of the key takeaways for E-Free Bemidji? What do you find most encouraging? What do you find most concerning? Please pray that E-Free Bemidji will become more and more the church that God would have us be.
