Sermon-based Discussion Questions

1. How might you explain the similarities and differences between “Sinners & Saints”?
2. Revelation 6:1-8 talks about the “Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse.” In verse 4 the rider takes peace from the earth and people start killing each other. Do you think part of God’s wrath may just be allowing our human sinfulness to take its course? Explain.
3. In Revelation 6:9-10, the martyred saints cry out “How long...until you avenge our blood?” Do you ever feel like God is taking too long to bring His justice and make things right in this world? Explain.
4. How do you think we might reconcile the martyrs’ prayer for vengeance in Revelation 6:10 with Jesus call to pray for our enemies in Matthew 5:43-45?

5. Revelation 6:16-17 talk about the wrath of the Lamb. Do you think God’s wrath contradicts His love? Explain.
6. How might Revelation 7:10 and 7:14 reveal that Revelation is a book of salvation?

7. Pray for any sinners you know who have not yet become saints.
