Sermon-based Discussion Questions

1. What comes to your mind when you think of dragons? Why do you think the Bible uses a dragon to symbolize Satan? (See Revelation 12:9)
2. Revelation 12-13 reveals how the devil wages war as an accuser and a deceiver. What are some specific examples of how the devil might be waging this war today?
3. Revelation 12:11 says that we triumph over the devil by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony. How do you think this might work in our everyday lives?
4. Revelation 13 describes the activity of two different beasts who are working with the dragon. What do you think this antichrist and false prophet teach us about the devil's schemes? (See also 1 John 2:18 and 2 John 7.)
5. In light of all that we read in Revelation 13-14, why do you think there's a call for patient endurance and faithfulness from God's people? (See Revelation 13:9-10; 14:11-13.)
