## Sermon-based Discussion Questions

1. Have you ever helped sing the Hallelujah Chorus or heard it performed by a large choir? Why do you think it's become such a cherished song for so many of us?
2. Read Revelation 19:1-8. Does it surprise you at all that the response to judgment is rejoicing? Why or why not? (See also Revelation 18:20)
3. What does Revelation 19:7-9 tell us about the bride of Christ? Do you know any other Scriptures that talk about her? (See 2 Corinthians 11:2; Ephesians 5:25-27; and Revelation 21:2-3)
4. Read the description of Jesus in Revelation 19:11-16. According to this, who is Jesus and what does He do?
5. Revelation 20:1-10 teaches us about the thousand year reign with Christ. Do you ever think of yourself as someone who reigns with Christ? Explain.  
Does it surprise you that even after 1,000 years of Jesus' earthly reign, people are still deceived by the devil? Why or why not?
6. Read Revelation 20:11-15. Do you think people are judged according to what they've done or according to whether their name is in the book of life? Explain.
7. What are you most looking forward to when evil comes to its final end?
