1 Thessalonians 4:13-18



SPOILER ALERT: *You may not want to read these until
AFTER you have heard the sermon.*

1. Can you remember a time when you had to wait for a long time for a loved one to return home? What were some of the thoughts and emotions that you went through during your wait?
2. When you think of Jesus, do you tend to picture Him as a suffering servant or as a glorious king? Explain.
Why are both important to our faith?
3. How would you explain salvation's past, present, and future dimensions? Why is it helpful to keep all 3 of these dimensions in mind?
4. What encourages you the most about Jesus' 2nd coming? Why is having a confident hope so valuable?
5. Do you have a personal opinion about the various millennial views: premillennial, postmillennial, or amillennial? Explain.
6. Read Titus 2:11-14 and talk about what it's saying.
How can our Life Group encourage you as you wait for Jesus' glorious return?
