- 1. Can you remember a time when you had to wait for a long time for a loved one to return home? What were some of the thoughts and emotions that you went through during your wait?
- 2. When you think of Jesus, do you tend to picture Him as a suffering servant or as a glorious king? Explain. Why are both important to our faith?
- 3. How would you explain salvation's past, present, and future dimensions? Why is it helpful to keep all 3 of these dimensions in mind?
- 4. What encourages you the most about Jesus' 2nd coming? Why is having a confident hope so valuable?
- Do you have a personal opinion about the various millennial views: premillennial, postmillennial, or amillennial? Explain.
- 6. Read Titus 2:11-14 and talk about what it's saying. How can our Life Group encourage you as you wait for Jesus' glorious return?
