- 1. When you hear the word "Mercy," what is one of the first things that comes to your mind? Share about a time when you needed to ask for someone's forgiveness? What were some of the thoughts and feelings you had?
- What comments or questions do you have about "the Parable of the Unmerciful Servant? You may want to re-read Matthew 18:21-35 to refresh your memory.
- 3. If someone hasn't repented, do you think that it might be wrong to forgive them? If someone hasn't repented, do you think that they can truly be restored? Explain.
- 4. When is forgiving others easy? When is it most difficult? Do you think partial forgiveness still "counts"?
- 5. How would you explain the connection between wickedness and being unmerciful? Do you have any questions about how God's forgiveness works?
- 6. What are some practical ways that our Life Group can practice mercy in our everyday lives? Is there a situation of unforgiveness in your life that we can pray for?
